Can I Certify a Fire Door?

Aims and objectives.

We have designed and produced this training package to meet the needs carpenters, joiners and their supervisors or managers that carry out inspection checks and sign-off during and post installation and maintenance works for timber-based fire doors.

This training module provides the necessary information to help those that are responsible for checking the works and signing it off to understand the requirements in terms of the checks that should be made, the records that should be kept and the documents that should be provided to the client on completion.

All learners for this training module should be competent and knowledgeable in understanding the requirements for compliant installation, maintenance and repairs to timber-based fire doors. Whilst it is not a requirement it is recommended that learners for this training module should have successfully completed the relevant fire door installation and/or fire door maintenance training.

Delivery.

- The final exam. Here we describe what happens in the examination.
